PINK ELEPHANT THRIFT SHOP RULES

- There is a \$2.00 fee to open an account. There is a \$2.00 fee to reactivate an account inactive for more than one year.
- New and gently used items are accepted for consignment. Clothing must be in style, in season, clean and pressed. All other items must be clean and in good working condition. Check your items carefully before bringing them in for consignment. We do not hold for pick up items we find to be unacceptable when we are tagging them for display. *Any item found to be stained, torn, out of style, broken, inoperable or incomplete will be automatically donated or discarded. NO EXCEPTIONS!!*
- Consignments of up to ten (10) items per day are accepted 9:30 a.m. – 10:45 a.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday unless prior arrangements are made with the Manager. The Pink Elephant Thrift Shop reserves the right to adjust the maximum number of items by category based on stock on hand and/or space available.
- Items accepted for consignment must be valued at least \$2.50. PRICING IS DONE BY PINK ELEPHANT STAFF. THE PRICER'S DECISION IS FINAL.
- The consignment period is 42 days or 6 weeks. For items sold during this period, the consignor will receive 50% of the selling price and the Pink Elephant will receive 50%. Items not sold during this period must be reclaimed on or before the pick-up date indicated on the inventory sheet. Otherwise, they become the property of the Pink Elephant. It is the consignor's responsibility to check on the status of consignment items and reclaim them on or before the pick-up date.
- THE PINK ELEPHANT THRIFT SHOP IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST, BROKEN OR STOLEN ITEMS.
- Payment for sales is made monthly by check, available by the fifth of the month. Consignors may pick up their checks or have them mailed by providing a legal-sized, self-addressed stamped envelope. Checks not cashed within 90 days of the issue date are void and considered a donation to the Pink Elephant Thrift Shop. Void or lost checks will not be reissued. NO EXCEPTIONS.
